Class III – Application fee shall be \$125 – due at time of application – for one or more individual private docks (Maximum 5 year term). Mooring buoys, swim rafts or other structures require a Class III permit. Checks or money orders only, payable to **Iowa Department of Natural Resources**.

Permittee shall pay an annual administrative fee of \$50 for each hoist or slip in excess of a total of 4 hoists or slips.

The hoist/slip fee shall be due on March 1 of each year or whenever a permit is modified by adding a hoist or slip. Any fees owed to the department shall be paid in full prior to the installation of any portion of an individual private dock. **Application and hoist/slip fees are non-refundable.**

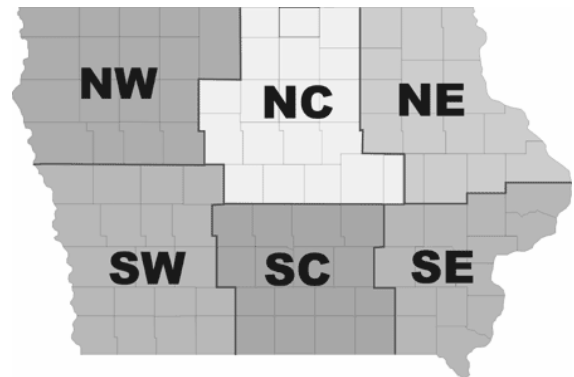

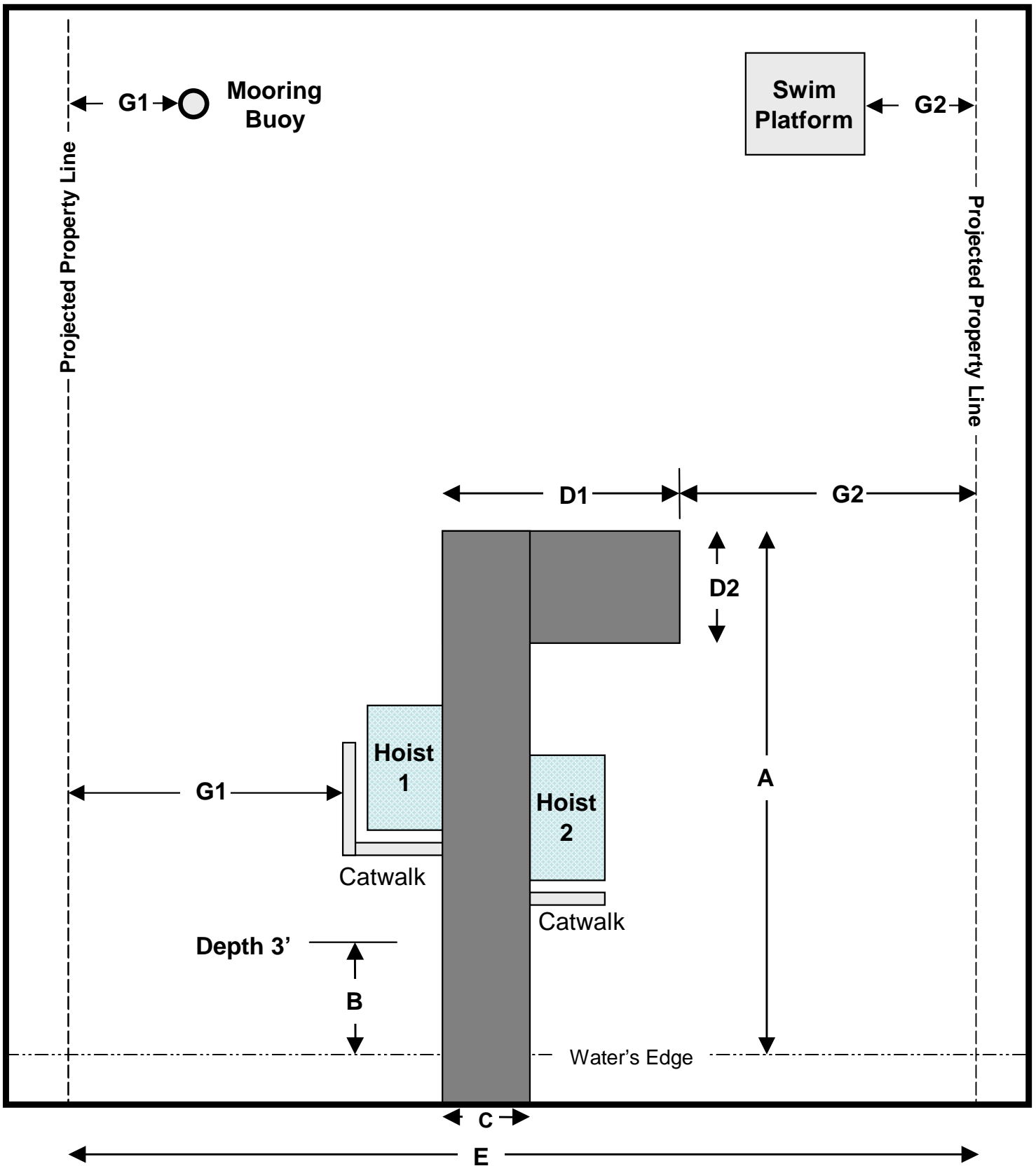
